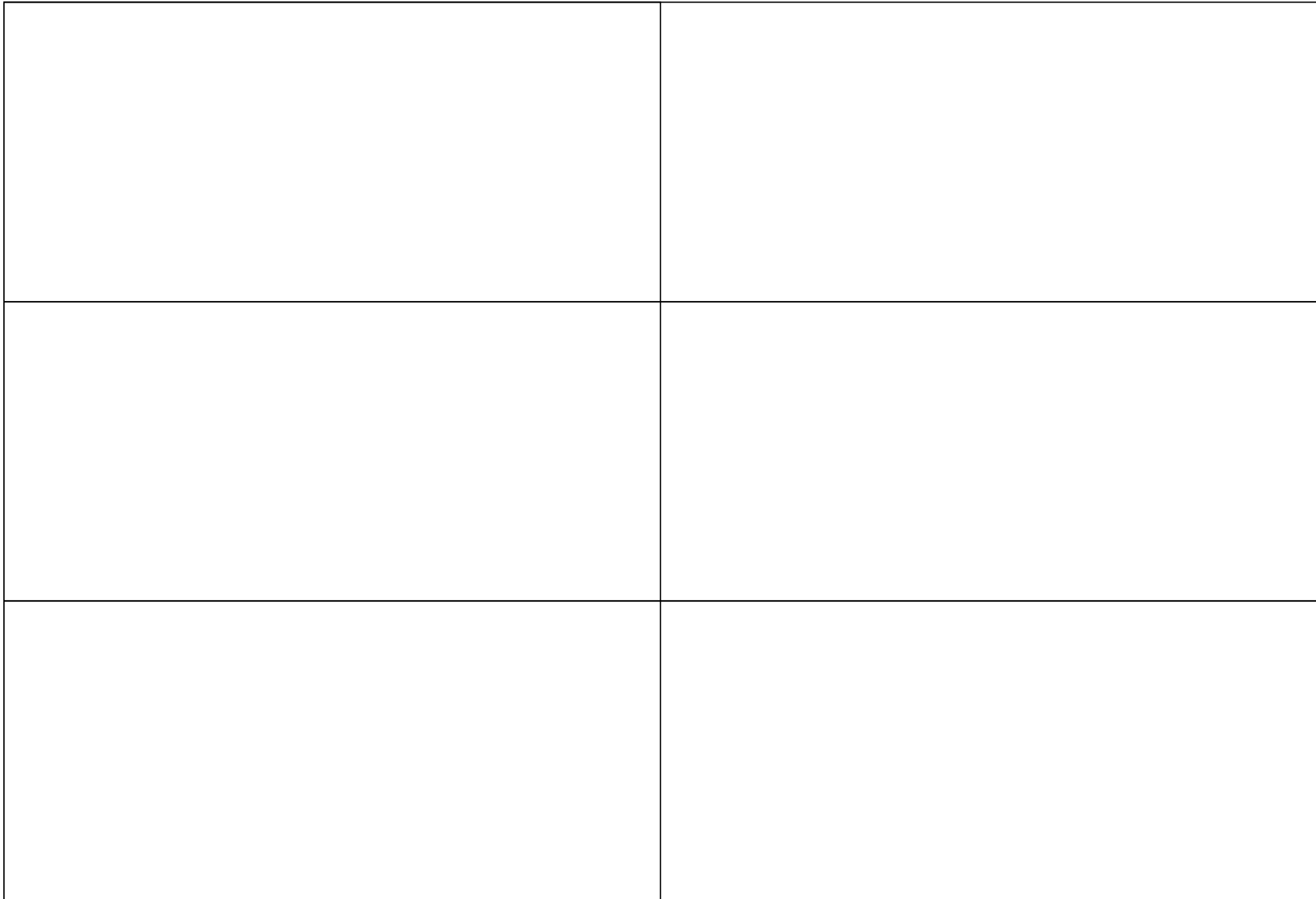


Top of external tank. Print on colored cardstock paper (20 cents a sheet at staples save your inker!!!!)

Roll these sections into cylinders, use some of the scrap to make tabs. After joining, I like to take extra sheets of paper, junk mail, etc, and roll it into tubes and allow them to spring open in the chamber of the cylinders. Add a little glue if necessary to secure. This adds stiffness to the cylinder and gives the model a more substantial feel when holding, (think, “wow its so heavy, is it really made out of only paper?”)



Bottom on external tank. Join with the top by cutting a joining cylinder out of the scrap paper. And fitting it in between the two cylinders.
